

Getting to Brooklyn Army Terminal

By Public Transportation

VIA Subway: Take the N and R lines to 59th Street in Brooklyn and walk west towards the waterfront. The main BAT entrance is located on 58th and 1st Ave.

Via Bus: Take the B11 from the R stop at 53rd Street and get off at the BAT entrance at 58th St and 1st Ave.

By Driving

Brooklyn Army Terminal is less than 20 minutes from Manhattan when taking either the Brooklyn Bridge or the Brooklyn Battery Tunnel and connecting to the Gowanus Expressway (I-278). Staten Island and New Jersey are each easily accessible from BKLYN Army Terminal via the nearby Verrazano-Narrows Bridge. Travel to JFK International Airport and Long Island is also convenient via the Belt Parkway.
